OFFICIAL RULES – REAL MONEY PAYMENTS

1. Qualifying Guidelines, Rules and Conditions.

- Real Money Program dates are from January 1 through December 31, 2008.
- Win shall be defined as “first place”.
- Eligible persons must possess a Yamaha powered Skeeter Boat, and said boat must be personally registered in the person’s name.
- Only Wins of those Local and Regional Contingency Paying Events posted on www.skeeterboats.com are eligible for payments. Local and Regional Contingency Paying Events may be added or deleted solely by Skeeter at any time.
- Only Local and Regional Contingency Paying Events with sixty (60) or more competing anglers will be considered for contingency payments, even if listed on Website or Program brochure. Meaning, if the Local, Regional and/or National Contingency Paying Event has less than sixty (60) competing anglers, it shall not be subject to a contingency payment.
- Persons employed by Skeeter Boats Inc., Yamaha Motor Corporation, USA and its affiliated companies are not eligible for this Real Money Program or Program payments.
- Skeeter Team members are eligible for this Real Money Program.
- Must fish from a SKEETER boat powered by a YAMAHA Engine.
- Registered owner’s name and winner must be the same name on warranty and/or state registration at the time of Win.
- Must be wearing a SKEETER or YAMAHA shirt and/or hat with logo exposure during competition days when permitted.
- Must display SKEETER Real Money Program decal on driver’s windshield/console of boat you are fishing from when permitted.
- Must display SKEETER truck decal.
- Tournament Finish Affidavit forms must be submitted within 30-days of tournament Win for eligibility review and qualification incentive. (Please allow four to six weeks for approval and processing.)
- Co-Anglers or non-boaters fishing from a SKEETER boat, even though they may own one, are not eligible. They must fish from their SKEETER boat and be classified as a single participant in the Contingency Paying Event.
- In the event of a team sanctioned event, only one contingency payment will be paid to the owner of the boat anglers are fishing from.
- Contingency payments will be awarded only to first place single overall winner of a Contingency Paying Event. Big fish awards, ties, and winners decided by chance are not eligible.
- Concurrent contingency paying events, where two or more events take place at the same time and allow entrants in each event to use the same fish for both weigh-ins, are NOT eligible.
- The SKEETER Owner is responsible for submitting the timely and completed SKEETER Real Money Registration Form to SKEETER Boats Inc.
- The angler is responsible for providing authentic and official verification of both ownership of the Skeeter/Yamaha package and a tournament Win and any other Rules and Condition requirements and guidelines.
- Skeeter Boats reserves the right to enhance, change, alter, modify or terminate the Real Money Program at its sole discretion at any time. Final Real Money Program eligibility and contingency payment authorization will be determined only by Skeeter Boats.
- Income and other taxes are the responsibility of recipient.

OFFICIAL RULES – REAL MONEY PAYMENTS

2. **How to Enter.** State BASS Federation Nation members who are eligible pursuant to these Official Rules must complete an official Real Money registration form as directed by Skeeter and submit said form by regular mail, website submission or fax prior to participating in any of the sanctioned events listed hereunder. Contestants will be notified via regular mail once their registration has been approved by Skeeter. Regular mail submissions may be sent to this address: Skeeter Products, Inc., Attn: Skeeter Real Money, One Skeeter Road, Kilgore, TX 75662. Website submissions may be completed by following this link: www.skeeterboats.com/events/real_money/online_registration. Faxed submissions may be faxed to 903.988.2711. Official registration forms must be received no later than twenty-four (24) hours prior to the sanctioned event in which the contestant is entering. All entries are the property of Skeeter and will not be returned. Skeeter is not responsible for submissions or entries, claims or notices that are lost, late, illegible, misdirected, damaged, incomplete or postage due. **There is a \$24.95 registration fee associated with submission of the official registration form,** and entry fees shall apply for the sanctioned events. A State BASS Federation Nation member must use his/her registered boat required in Qualifying Guidelines above as his/her primary tournament boat while participating in said sanctioned event, unless said sanctioned event is a sanctioned event where official event rules preclude an angler from using his/her personal boat.
3. **Sanctioned Events.** BASS Federation Nation members must enter at least one of the following listed events in order to be eligible to win any Real Money reward described in these Official Rules:
- State BASS Federation Nation Chapter Divisional Qualifying Events (each State sets their qualifying formats, check your affiliated State Chapter Tournament Schedule for approved events).
 - BASS Federation Nation Divisional (6 events)
 - Bass Club World Championship Qualifying Events (5 events)
 - Bass Club World Championship (1 event)

Dates and details of all “Real Money” sanctioned events may be found at www.skeeterboats.com.

Skeeter is not responsible for the promotion or organization of, nor the rules governing, the sanctioned events, which in each case are the responsibility of the organizers of said sanctioned events. Information found at www.skeeterboats.com regarding Real Money sanctioned events are deemed reliable, however, is subject to change, and, in any case, Skeeter is not responsible for the accuracy of such information.

4. **Winner Determination.** A potential winner, if any, shall be responsible for obtaining and completing a Real Money Finish Affidavit. Real Money Finish Affidavits will be available on the Skeeter website, or upon request by email, mail or fax. The claim form must be completed and submitted by said potential winner along with verification of a Yamaha powered Skeeter boat being registered in his/her name as required by these Official Rules, verification of his/her winning finish in the sanctioned event, and verification of compliance with all other of these Official Rules, via regular mail, electronic mail or fax transmission in the manner described in Section 2 above, within 30 days of the sanctioned event at which the win occurred. Skeeter is not responsible for claim forms or supporting materials that are lost, late, illegible, misdirected, damaged, incomplete or postage due. Winners, if any, should allow eight weeks for approval, processing and shipment via U.S. mail of prize amount from the date of receipt of the claim form and all supporting materials described herein.

5. **Prizes.** The following prize amounts based on model year and/or horsepower of boat package will be available to be won at each sanctioned event as listed in section 3. If there is no winner, no prize will be awarded.
- **\$3,000 CASH.** Fish & Win a sanctioned event using a 2008 or newer model Skeeter Boat powered by a 225 horsepower Yamaha engine or larger and you will be eligible for \$3,000 for a Win.
 - **\$2,000 CASH.** Fish & Win a sanctioned event using a 2008 or newer model Skeeter Boat powered by a 200 horsepower Yamaha engine or a 2007 Skeeter Boat powered by a 225 or larger and you will be eligible for \$2,000 for a Win.
 - **\$1,000 CASH.** Fish & Win a sanctioned event using your Skeeter Boat powered by a Yamaha engine and you will be eligible for \$1,000 for a Win.

OFFICIAL RULES – EXTENDED REAL MONEY REWARDS FOR STATE BASS FEDERATION NATION MEMBERS

1. **\$50,000** for winning the 2008 Federation Nation Championship
- **Extended Real Money Guidelines, Rules, Terms and conditions.** This cash award will respond to only a State BASS Federation Nation Chapter Member who is a First Place Points Champion of the scheduled 2008 Federation Nation Championship tournament tour. The 2008 Federation Nation Championship is to be held on the dates November 6-8, 2008 at the venue Milford Lake out of Junction City Kansas. The "Winner" must be the original owner of a 2006 or later model Yamaha powered Skeeter Boat and used said boat in a minimum of 50% of the qualifying tournaments to ultimately win the overall individual 2008 Federation Nation Championship. The eligible Yamaha powered Skeeter boat must have been purchased new from an authorized Skeeter dealer. A "tournament prize" boat, won in the normal and customary manner of tournament fishing will be considered eligible for this promotion. No free "team", "memo" or special contract boats are eligible. Only new retail sold 2006, 2007, 2008 or 2009 Model Yamaha powered Skeeter Boats will be eligible. Skeeter will require proof of sale i.e. sales contract and proof of warranty registration as a condition precedent for claims consideration, as well as proof of State Chapter Membership. An eligible Member must be one of the six Bass Federation Nation Divisional Championship anglers selected to fish in the ensuing Bassmaster Classic event. Winner must agree to use his/her Skeeter boat powered by Yamaha in the ensuing Bassmaster Classic event. Winner must agree to wear Skeeter and Yamaha provided tournament jersey and hat in the ensuing Bassmaster Classic event. This offering is for one (1) single overall 2008 Federation Nation Championship winner who is also a State BASS Federation Nation Chapter Member.

OFFICIAL RULES – EXTENDED REAL MONEY REWARDS FOR STATE BASS FEDERATION NATION MEMBERS

2. **\$100,000** for winning the 2009 Bassmaster Classic.
 - This cash award will respond to only a State BASS Federation Nation Chapter Member who is a First Place Aggregate Weight of the scheduled 2009 Bassmaster Classic event, Shreveport, Louisiana, February 20-22, 2009. The 2009 "Classic Winner" must be the original owner of a 2006 or later model Yamaha powered Skeeter Boat and used said boat in tournament fishing to ultimately qualify for the Bassmaster Classic via the Federation Nation tour. The eligible Yamaha powered Skeeter boat must have been purchased new from an authorized Skeeter dealer. A "tournament prize" boat, won in the normal and customary manner of tournament fishing will be considered eligible for this promotion. No free "team", "memo" or special contract boats are eligible. Only new retail sold 2006; 2007, 2008 or 2009 Model Yamaha powered Skeeter Boats will be eligible. Skeeter will require proof of sale i.e. sales contract and proof of warranty registration as a condition precedent for claims consideration, as well as proof of State Chapter Membership. An eligible Member must be one of the six total Bass Federation Nation Divisional Championship anglers selected to fish in the 2009 Bassmaster Classic. Winner must agree to use his/her Skeeter boat powered by Yamaha in the 2009 Bassmaster Classic event. Winner must agree to wear Skeeter and Yamaha provided tournament jersey and hat in the 2009 Bassmaster Classic event. This offering is for one (1) single overall 2009 Bassmaster Classic winner, who is also a State BASS Federation Nation Chapter Member.
